The Corporation of the Township of Burpee and Mills

By-Law No. 02 - 2016

Being a By-Law Requiring Work Permits to Authorize Permanent Alterations of Municipal Marine Allowances

WHEREAS Section 10(2) of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, authorizes the Council of the Township of Burpee and Mills to pass by-laws that regulate activities on Municipal property.

NOW THEREFORE: the Council of the Township of Burpee and Mills enacts as follows:

- 1. That we adopt a By-law to prohibit:
 - (a) Construction or placement of permanent structures on municipal marine allowances,
 - (b) Construction of roads on municipal marine allowances,
 - (c) Dredging municipal marine allowances for water diversion, or to provide water access.
 - (d) Filling of municipal marine allowances to dam natural water flow, to reclaim land, or to create a recreation area,

Unless acting under the authority of the terms and conditions of a work permit granted by the Municipality of Burpee and Mills.

- 2. Any application for permission to make an above-described permanent alteration on the Municipal Marine Allowance shall be submitted and approved prior to beginning any work. (Applicant is responsible for adherence to Federal and Provincial regulations.)
- 3. Every person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to the maximum fines as allowed by the Municipal Act or Provincial Offences Act as applicable.
- 4. Section 466 of the Municipal Act authorizes a municipality to enforce compliance of this by-law requiring work to be done to repair the damage and restore the land to its original condition within 30 days and to the satisfaction of the Municipality. If not in compliance within the specified time frame, the Municipality may enter onto the land, perform the necessary work and add the Municipality's cost to the offenders tax roll, collecting these costs in the same manner as property taxes.
- 5. Notice of violation shall be in a standard form approved by Council and may be served personally or by registered mail in which case service shall be deemed to be on the fourth day of mailing.
- 6. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the date that it is finally read and passed by the Council of the Township of Burpee and Mills.
